REPAIRS AND RENNOVATION



Planned improvements for the future include continuing with roofs where needed, staining building exteriors as required, and the continuation of interior improvements. DVD players are being purchased for various units in need of new equipment. Staff is looking into wireless internet for each unit but such an upgrade is expensive and need further study.

The Causeway on Gull Board continues to work closely with the State of Minnesota to insure our hot tubs are both safe and in close compliance with Minnesota Health Codes. Replacing some of the plumbing equipment for our hot tubs will bring us in closer compliance with Minnesota Codes.



Some of the Oak Trees at Causeway have been weakened or are no longer healthy due to drought conditions or age and as a result they have been invaded by a beetle that kills the tree by eating out the center core robbing the tree

of needed nutrients. This fall, our maintenance staff has had to remove approximately 50 trees throughout the Resort. During the fall the beetles go dormant which is the best time to remove the trees and burn them. The plan is to replace trees throughout the resort with various varieties that would thrive in the area. We understand no one wants trees to be removed but we must protect our tree resources by removing these trees and starting a replacement program.
